You do **not** think you need a guardian.

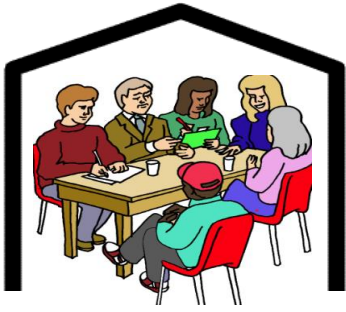
You do **not** agree with your legal paper.

Or



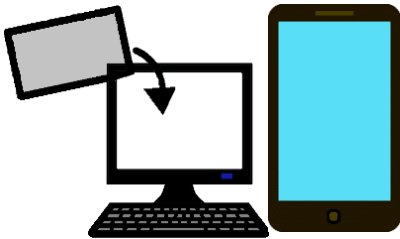
You do **not** want this guardian.

You can ask for a new meeting.

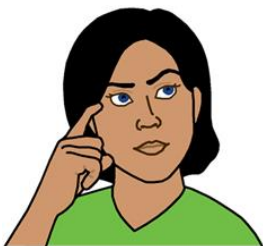
It is called the Tribunal.

or

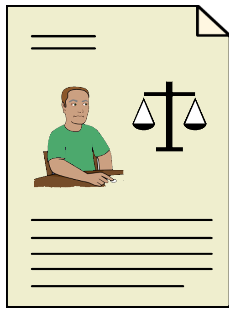


- you can have a different guardian

- you do **not** need a guardian.



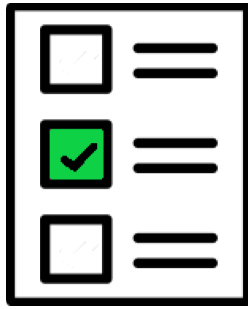
You may get a new legal paper.

They will look at your legal paper.



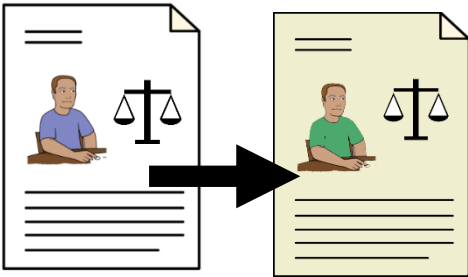
You can ask a lawyer to help you.

or



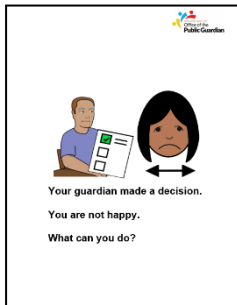
- your legal paper will change.

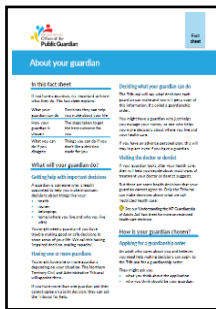
